FamilySearch Scavenger Hunt

****The purpose of this activity is to become familiar with FamilySearch through a scavenger hunt. This activity will help people learn more about and use key parts of FamilySearch.org.*

****Help participants feel the Spirit during this activity by allowing them to make connections between the tools available on FamilySearch.org and how these tools can help them grow closer to their family and find ancestors' names to take to the temple.*

1. Make sure all youth in your ward have an account with familysearch.org before the activity if possible. If they need help creating an account, help them get one set up before the activity.
2. Encourage all youth in your ward to sign on to FamilySearch.org prior to the activity and become as familiar as they can with familysearch.org.
3. Invite the youth to visit the Family History Center prior to the activity during youth hours: Tuesdays, Wednesday, or Thursdays from 3-5 pm if they would like some extra help.
4. Use the worksheet (provided at your activity) to complete various FamilySearch scavenger Hunt tasks.
5. Prizes will be awarded at the activity:
 - a. First person to do a "test drive" of indexing
 - b. First person to upload/add a memory to one of their ancestors
 - c. First person to complete the worksheet
